Attention 8th-grade parents: All 8th-grade students will take the CollegeBoard PSAT 8/9 (Preliminary SAT) on November 4, 2019. The PSAT 8/9 tests the same skills and knowledge as the SAT in a way that makes sense for eighth-graders. It measures what they're already learning, shows them whether they're on track for college and lets them know where they need to most improve. That means students have time to tackle these areas long before they take the SAT for college admission.

Attention 8th-grade parents: All 8th-grade students received a **Promotion Letter in October** to be signed by the student and parent/guardian. These letters were handed out in their Science class and must be returned with both signatures. As a reminder, an 8th-grade student may participate in Promotion activities if they pass each class with a **D average** for the year. The yearly average grade is comprised of 1<sup>st</sup> semester and 2nd-semester grades in each of their classes, including Physical Education and electives. In addition, any 8th-grade student suspended in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter will lose the privilege to attend the promotion dance and the Great America trip. Administration will determine if a suspended student can participate in the promotion ceremony. All 8<sup>th</sup> grade students need to be responsible for <u>academics</u> and <u>behavior</u>!
